The Lord that Thirsts Rev. Cody Mills

John 1:28-30 <sup>28</sup> Later, knowing that everything had now been finished, and so that Scripture would be fulfilled, Jesus said, "I am thirsty." <sup>29</sup> A jar of wine vinegar was there, so they soaked a sponge in it, put the sponge on a stalk of the hyssop plant, and lifted it to Jesus' lips. 30 When he had received the drink, Jesus said, "It is finished." With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.

Before His death, Jesus said it was time for Him to drink. Besides the physical thirst, He knew the cup coming to His lips will transfer sin and death to Him. The prediction of Christ's death can be found in Psalm 22 and Psalm 69. Psalm 69:21 "They gave me poison for food, and for my thirst they gave me sour wine to drink." This fulfilling why Jesus said I thirst. He knew He would be receiving sour wine to drink, fulfilling His death's prediction. We also remember Matthew 26:39 "...My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as you will."

In Matthew 26, the cup seals death and the entire sin of the World unto Him. Jesus was afraid to die and suffer wrath. Indeed, this drink will be sour and cannot satisfy the physical or spiritual thirst. Though Christ pleads with His Father in Heaven, He knows there will be a moment when the taste of death must cross His lips to free those that believe in Him. He knows He is dying for the sinner and unfaithful. He is dying for the disciples that have fallen asleep in the garden.

When Christ is on the Cross, He speaks the words to fill the prophecy and what He speaks constantly. His love is fulfilled by drinking the very cup he wanted the Father to not give. That sour taste of death must be given to Him. He is ready to die and take the world's weight unto Himself by saying, "I am thirsty!"

As we approach Holy Week, remember those Words that God gives us. By His life, He drinks the cup of death and the soured life of sin to become sin. 2 Corinthians 5:21 "Him who knew no sin, he made to be sin on our behalf; that we might become the righteousness of God in him."

Through faith, God gives us the cross in all its horror and beauty. That which is meant for torment and death remains the torment for death. God's promise in baptism and His body and blood that resurrects and sustains us gives us God's grace. Let us know what it means to receive the Gospel, our baptism, and the body and blood. These things are for you while Jesus drinks the cup given to Him to free us. By the blood of Jesus, you are saved so that nobody may boast of their own goods and works. There is nothing you can do that Jesus did. Let us eat and drink on Maundy Thursday to receive His gifts.




