

He is Risen Rev. Cody Mills

He is risen! He is risen indeed! That means you are immortal, and you are resurrected in Christ. As Christians, we find this to be great news. But for the sinner, this news is absolutely devastating. Hearing the news about the risen Lord is one to celebrate and fear.

God is one to be feared because death could not hold Him! The rising of the Lord proved that the dead will no longer stay dead. Indeed, the Lion of Judah is on the prowl. He is looking for those that continue to try and hide. Jesus Christ is the venom to the devil and death, and at the same time, He is the salvation, remedy, and life for you. This is the rebirth that Jesus was trying to tell Nicodemus on the night they met. Hosea 13:14 reveals, "He devours death and destroys it."

Now that you know Christ is risen, stand and confidently say, "I am a Christian indeed! Death has no authority over me, and I can confidently know that my life is free." If you believe in the words that Christ died for our sins, then there is a rebirth. It is belief in this rebirth that we can pierce the very heart of the devil.

There is only one way a person can survive the jaws of death. Not by wearing the works we do as a badge of honor to present to the Lord, but rather to say to the devil himself that you concede and are burdened with sin. But it is the serpent that was lifted up on the tree that has set me free from your jaws of eternity!"

As Martin Luther says, "Remember that we have lived damnably! But heavenly Father, Thou hast given me Thy Son; secondly, He earned heaven as the Son of Man with His suffering, death, and resurrection. And thus, He has also given and bestowed heaven on me."

Now we can look at the cross and know the object is our death, and the empty tomb is our resurrection. We look at this tree that brings death and boast in His work, "There is where Christ died for me so that I may live!" Here, we can see how much our Lord and Savior adored His Creation to adorn us with jewels and garments.

Once again, Martin Luther is elegant with his words, "Faith is not paltry and petty; but it is a heartfelt confidence in God through Christ that Christ's suffering and death pertain to you and should belong to YOU! True Faith does not doubt; it yields its whole heart to the conviction that the Son of God was given into death for us, that sin is remitted, that death is destroyed, and that these evils have been done away with – but, more than this, that eternal life, salvation, and glory, yes, God Himself have been restored to us, and that through the Son God has made us His Children."

These are the living Words that Christ gives to us. The Son shall be saved from death so that you shall be saved. Amen.
